Who should we contact about pot holes and flooding?

Norfolk County Council is responsible for maintaining most of the 6000 miles of road in Norfolk. Any issues brought to the attention of the Parish Council are reported to the County Council via the same online portal available to the public. There is strength in numbers and the more people that contact the County Council about a specific issue will naturally mean that the profile of that problem is raised. We will continue to report problems as they arise but advise parishioners to also contact the County Council directly. Their website is easy to navigate and any type of problem concerning roads, pavements, cycleways, public rights of way or trails can be reported:
